

Important Information For Southpoint Parents  
MEDICAL FORMS 3040 & 680

Within 30 days of your child's enrollment, Florida law requires you to provide the Center with the two forms mentioned below which indicate your child's health status:

1] Physical Examination, signed by a medical professional. This form will be provided by your child's doctor and will be good for two years. This is FORM 3040.

2] Current Florida Certificate of Immunization which is a large blue card, FORM 680, and will be provided by your child's doctor.

After the 30 day grace period, we must remove your child from the Center until the forms are presented. There is an administrative fine imposed by the Department Of Children & Families if this information is not current.

If you are unable to get a doctor's appointment in time, the Health Department can administer these shots.
